AutoCAD History AutoCAD is a commercial application that incorporates the capability to draw and prepare drawings of architecture, engineering, construction, graphics, and manufacturing. It has been continuously developed since 1982, as a primary application for desktop personal computers with visual display terminals (VDTs). AutoCAD is built on the idea of combining art and engineering through the use of a workbench that enables the designer to work in the field in a unique way. Its development began with a graphical interface that allowed for the preparation of accurate, precise drawings and was soon followed by an integrated feature set, including a mouse-controlled three-dimensional (3D) modeling environment. AutoCAD was a groundbreaking product for its time and was an immediate success. By the end of 1985, more than 400,000 licenses were sold and the program was introduced in 27 languages on 16 different operating systems. Notable users include Disney, FedEx, Hewlett Packard, and the United States Postal Service. AutoCAD has been sold to over 500,000 users in over 100 countries, and is estimated to generate over \$200 million per year in revenue. License and support The cost of AutoCAD includes a license for one user (commercial). An individual license is priced at \$1000 CAD or \$800 USD, and the "University" license (available at no additional charge for academic users) allows for the creation of ten or more users within a single enterprise. A commercial license for AutoCAD can also be acquired for use on a group of computers or on a network. The program is regularly updated with a new release that is supported by the AutoCAD Team, consisting of a user base of around 100. The AutoCAD Team is responsible for creating new features, improving the product, and developing the user interface. As part of the licensing agreement, the company sends a PDF document that outlines the latest changes. These documents are sent to users with a valid serial number. New version releases are typically released every six months, and each release requires a new serial number to access the software. Since the early 2000s, AutoCAD software has been available free of charge to individuals or organizations who are willing to provide that user with free support in a forum, e-mail, chat, or other online assistance that is available on Autodesk's website. Publication and documentation of AutoCAD was handled by Help Desk Software, a subsidiary of Autodesk, with the company shut down in 2006, and with the company's trademark infringement lawsuits against the company. Between 2000 and 2010, Autodesk held the "AutoCAD Summer Camp" in Las Vegas, a three-day event for Autodesk software developers to develop on Autodesk's software. History AutoCAD (previously named AutoCAD R14) was the third of Autodesk's Autocad products, and the first general-purpose CAD system for the Windows platform. (Intuition was released in 1989 and DesignCenter in 1991.) AutoCAD was released on November 12, 1990. In 1993, Autodesk also released the Autocad 2000 DGN Converter, a plugin that could convert a DGN (1992) to a native.DWG file format. In 1993, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2.0, replacing AutoCAD R14 with a faster and more stable.DLL. The first major change was the introduction of native Windows 3.x (called Windows 95 and Windows NT 3.1 in 1994) support, although Windows 2.x still ran in "Safe Mode" if Windows 3.x compatibility was enabled. The new.DLL file format was developed by John Young and Adrian Griffiths. This new version was marketed as "Dimensional Analysis" in early 1994. AutoCAD 2.5 was announced in October 1995, with version 2.5 running on Windows 95. This version included a new toolbar and an improved window manager, and the ability to view 3D surfaces as well as 2D surfaces. This version was available in both 2D and 3D versions (with special 3D drawing capabilities in 2D). Although the release of AutoCAD 2.5 was delayed until early 1996, Autodesk released 2.5 beta in the fall of 1995. AutoCAD 2.6 was announced in February 1996, with a new command-line interface, new painting tools, and a more stable document format (only one file format was shipped in versions of AutoCAD up to that point).
